V. Requirements for International Students

2. Compulsory Courses for Korean Language

* Students who are below the TOPIK level 4 must take both **A** and **B** courses after admission.

A. Register regular one course of Korean language training at Dankook University International Language Center (Students must submit the transcript after attending the course.)

B. "Korean for Graduate students" class(3 credits) in the first semester.
In the first semester, international students can't enroll for more than 6 credits ("Korean for Graduate students" 3 credits + Major 3 credits) If a student fails to take the credit for "Korean for Graduate students" class, he/she can only register for 9 credits("Korean for Graduate students" + major 6 credit) in the second semester.

C. Students who have completed **B** may register for extra 3 credits for major field per semester, during as many semesters as the ones for "Korean for Graduate students" courses.

* Applicants eligible to ② of the Admission Requirements above, may submit a statement for writing an English term paper to the head professor of the department, and are exempted from the B Course (Korean for Graduate students).

VII Document Submission

1. If a Chinese national has acquired a degree in the US : Apostille confirmation, or a consul confirmation from the Korean consul stationed in the US or the American consul stationed in Korea
2. If an American citizen has acquired a degree in China : education/degree verification center report run by the Ministry of China in China or a consul confirmation of a Korean diplomatic mission in China

- ⑥ Official academic transcripts(applicants for Ph.D should include transcript for undergraduate studies) - one original copy
- ⑦ TOPIK level 3 or higher, regular English language proficiency test score(if applicable)
- ⑧ Proof of applicable country's government scholarship, recommendation letter from the president of affiliated universities(if applicable)

- ⑨ Portfolio for college of art applicants(if applicable)
- ⑩ Passport for the applicant & his/her parents each (or ID card, nationality confirmation)
 - **1 family relations certificate(copy of 户口簿 & 居民身份证 for Chinese nationals) :
Notarized in English - one original copy**
 - DKU M.A graduates may not submit family relations certificate (**for Chinese nationals**)
- ⑪ A register issued by local diplomatic office (Korean nationals residing abroad only)- one original copy
- ⑫ **Applicant's or Sponsor(Parents)'s VOD(Verification of Deposit) indicating that more than USD 20,000 in funds**
 - **Only DKU enrolled students VOD reduced to USD 10,000**
 - **Must be in deposit for at least 1 month or longer**
 - **VOD(Verification of Deposit) issued by Chinese Bank need to frozen funds until 31, Aug, 2018**
- ⑬ Dormitory candidates : **Tuberculosis diagnosis**
- ⑭ **Dormitory entrance is mandatory and students are required to live throughout the first two semesters. Students who cannot live in dorm for certain reasons should submit explanatory statement(signed) before the semester begins.**
Students who wants to cancel dormitory entrance must notify graduate school office by Aug 24.
Leaving dormitory after the semester may cause disadvantage.
- ⑮ Transfer applicants : Graduation certificate or certificate of registration(of the previous university)
- ※ All documents in foreign language must be accompanied by a notarized English(or Korean) translation

2. Special Notes for Submission

- 1) Official Graduate Certificate and Academic Transcript of graduates of foreign universities(or graduate schools) should be notarized. A Personal Information Release Consent Form must be submitted, with the address of the university, contact number of the university, the name of the person in charge of register, email address written on the front page.
- 2) Chinese university graduates must submit a certificate of Chinese degree issued by the Chinese embassy and 中國高等教育學歷查詢報告(www.chsi.com.cn, www.cdgd.edu.cn).
- 3) **For applicants from foreign universities**, if academic accreditation of the university from the country is unclear, a notary from the Embassy may be required.
- 4) If transferred from lower level of degree, applicant should submit official academic transcript from the previous university(one original copy).

IX. Scholarships

1. Scholarship will be awarded to the admitted students who enrolled in undergraduate-graduate linkage course, and can shorten 1 semester if eligible for completion.
2. Dankook scholarship will be awarded to the admitted students from Dankook undergraduate/graduate school.
3. Students nominated as TA or RA will be given scholarship.
4. **Admitted foreign students will be given scholarship(30% ~ 50% tuition based).
(In the 1st and the 2nd semester, boarding fees will be subsidized)**
5. Other internal/external scholarships will be awarded by the recommendation of academic advisor or chair professor.

X. Notes for Applicants

1. Application Related Notices

- ① After application, an applicant should submit required documents within the deadline, and **failing to comply with supplementation of required documents before the given dates will entail a dropout from the admission process.** Original copies should be submitted, if not, photocopies should be compared and confirmed with the original.
- ② The application process completes with the payment of the application fee, which is non-refundable. All the documents will not be returned.
- ③ **All documents issued in foreign languages (except English) should be translated and notarized in Korean before submission. English documents are accepted with the Korean translation.**
- ④ **All department announcements will be made on-line at DKU Graduate School web-site.**
- ⑤ Prospective graduates among admitted students must submit the "official certificate of graduation" and "official academic transcript" to the graduate school office of the registrar(room 317) before the course begins.
- ⑥ **Admitted students should make a payment of the tuition until the date appointed, nonpayment will entail cancellation of the admission.** (The list of admitted students will be announced on-line at DKU graduate school webpage. **Please be noted that individual notification will not be made.**
- ⑦ **Refund of the tuition** : Refund will be followed by "Regulation of university tuition" from the Ministry of education.
- ⑧ **Refund of the application fee** : Application fee is refundable if applicants submit a proof of unavoidable circumstances (natural disaster, illness) to miss the interview.
- ⑨ Official Academic Transcripts must specify grade point average, and Graduate Certificate must have a registration number.
- ⑩ Applicants cannot apply two or more departments/courses.
- ⑪ Successful candidates cannot apply during additional application period. If so, applicants should give up their previous admission.

2. Admission Related Notices

- ① **If any required documents are found to be false or counterfeit, the admission to DKU Graduate School will be cancelled.**
- ② Entrance examination scores are not publicized.
- ③ Regardless of the ranking policies, there can be minimum standards for admission, and applicants below which may not be admitted.
- ④ Disagreement for the release of the academic records may lead to the cancellation of the admission.

XI. Etc.

- ① Students are allowed to apply different majors from their undergraduate studies for MA & Ph.D. Degree.
- ② **Terms of study and credits**
Terms of study for MA and Ph.D courses are 2 years each or more, integrated course is more than 42 months.
- ③ Students whose majors are different from undergraduate or MA studies, or students graduated from special graduate school, are required to earn certain credits for prerequisite undergraduate or graduate courses.
- ④ Some departments can replace MA thesis to degree work or research paper. Please contact the department office for further information.
