OASIS-4(Start-up Class), OASIS-5(Boot Camp) and OASIS-8 programs are designed to provide opportunities to 'enhance understanding of the business environment and strengthen start-up capabilities'.

We encourage potential candidates who want to establish a start-up to participate.

Eligibility | Foreigners who wish to establish a domestic corporation, obtain a technology start-up visa, and engage in start-up activities.

Objective | Support for foreigners creating a domestic tech start-up by providing programs such as education, mentoring, and corporate establishment.
